Position Description

The Baker Resources Coalition (BRC) is hiring up to four high school students (16+) for its 2023 Summer Internship Program. This is an opportunity to explore different facets of natural resource management. You will work on projects assisting land managers, gain insights into roles natural resources serve in meeting community needs, and learn practical skills in forest, watershed, and wildlife management. You will work under the direction of landowners, managers, or specialists who will share their knowledge, skills, and most importantly, their love for the outdoors. This is a 10-week internship with compensation of **\$15.00 an hour**. Interns will work 5 days a week, approximately 6 hours per day, with an additional hour of compensation provided if project sites exceed 30 minutes of travel from Baker City. You **must** provide your own transportation to and from project sites!

If selected for this internship, you will attend orientation on Friday, June 9th, for a briefing of work schedule, planned projects, project locations, host's expectations, and other pertinent information. You must arrive on time to each project, be ready to work hard, learn, and have fun.
